Conditions of ACHV Travel Awards

1. The awards are open to currently enrolled PhD students and early career scientists. Time since completion of PhD, BSc or equivalent should not be more than 5 years (or equivalent with justified career interruptions).
2. **The money is to be used for travel related to attending a scientific meeting or conducting research on hepatitis viruses**

The award must be used in the calendar year it was awarded either pro or retrospectively. eg if awarded in June 2019, the award must be used between Jan 1 2019 to Dec 31 2019.

3. Applications for travel awards should include:

The completed application, and if applicable:

- A copy of an abstract of the work to be presented
 - A letter of invitation from the visiting research lab head
4. Individuals awarded the travel awards are not eligible to re-apply in the subsequent two years.
 5. Applications will only be accepted from current ACHV members. Individuals wishing to apply for the ACHV Travel awards and are not current members must complete a Membership application form which can be obtained from the ACHV website (www.achv.org.au) and emailed with their ACHV application to the secretary (r.bull@unsw.edu.au). Application deadline 15th June, 2019.
 6. Award winners will be judged by a panel of senior hepatitis researchers and will be announced at the designated time. Decisions will be final and no appeals will be considered.
 7. ACHV reserves the right not to make an award in any given year.
 8. Award winners must acknowledge ACHV funding in their presentation, and include the ACHV logo on their slides.
 9. A short report (half a page) and image should be provided to the Secretary within 30 days of return from the conference that can be used for social media purposes and the ACHV website.
